2. Update from Corey on US-2 situation.

Corey did a power point presentation to explain what has occurred on US-2 and how the process has worked.

Two weeks ago, to the day after the City Council meeting the sink hole had started. MDOT was Petitioned to close the lane, MDOT elected to do a traffic shift.

Corey stated that on the 19th they knew that there was a significant breach in a sewer pipe. With Amount of sand coming in they knew it was a bigger pipe and started looking to see where the breech was located. They knew it was coming from the North part of town.

An action plan was started and followed. There had been a failure of the same pipe in May. The whole top of the pipe had been eaten away from sulfuric acid which is a byproduct of sewage.

There were two bypasses set up for sewage. A company out of Flat Rock is assisting with that process. The new pipe has been pulled through successfully. Everything they are working with is at a 20 ft. depth. There will be three manholes placed at and around this site, for this to be accomplished they must do some dewatering. All this was set up in two days.

The Council commended Corey and his staff with the quick response, dedication and hard work in the wake of the magnitude of this situation. These employees have worked around the clock to ensure the safety of the citizens of Manistique.

Corey also commended his staff, EGLE, Coleman, the Public Safety Department, MDOT and the contractors for their quick response in this matter.
