2. Public Hearing on CDBG Grant

Manager Sheila Aldrich memo: Our Wastewater Superintendent, Corey Barr would like to apply for a CDBG (Community Development Block Grant) from MEDC (Michigan Economic Development Corporation) to cover the cost of replacing old sewer line from the endpoint of the current replacement by US-2 to West Elk. It is approximately 1,000-foot run.

Corey Barr:

- There is an opportunity to apply for some funding through MEDC for the CDBG Grant.
 - This would assist us in furthering the work that was started last fall
 - The new project would start where they left off and will go through the property
 - The pipe that is being referred to is of the same vintage as the pipe that has had two previous failures
 - This would be an 11% match, the money is there to cover the match
 - The project would be to line the pipe and the manholes
 - This project will not take a rate increase and would be a 2021 construction project

- These groups on their own have contacted MDOT with no change taking place
- We are asking for City Council support of this resolution which will enhance safety in these areas
