2. Sea Lamprey Barrier Dam Construction

Manager Aldrich Memo. Jessica Barber from Fisheries will be at City Hall prior to our meeting for the required public hearing. She will also be at our meeting to bring Council up to date on the Sea Lamprey Dam Structure Project and to answer any questions Council might have concerning the project. This project has been many years in the works. It will be good to get information on the barrier dam and its projected completion date.

Jessica Barber gave her presentation on the Sea Lamprey Barrier Dam Construction Project. She told Council the timeline on the project includes environmental assessment & public comment through June 13 2018, refine and finalize design based on comments through 2018-2019, joint permit to DEQ in 2020, and do construction in June 2021.
